Interdisciplinary and Transdisciplinary Learning and Research (IDR) Policy

Interdisciplinary and transdisciplinary research breach disciplinary boundaries to enhance and deepen inquiry and learning. Thus, Interdisciplinary and transdisciplinary have become the hall mark of modern research across different subjects of study ranging from liberal arts to science and technology.

Inter Disciplinary Research (IDR) Policy for Kannur University:

- 1. It aims to create circumstances, opportunities, incentives, regarding extra-disciplinary scholarly linkages.**
- 2. This will be operationalised via curricula, syllabi, minimum qualifications and use of broader nomenclature for courses of study.**
- 3. Departments when making applications for university resources, e.g. for holding conferences and for research funding will be prioritised if they demonstrate a willingness to collaborate across disciplinary boundaries.**
- 4. To promote publication of interdisciplinary research journals.**
- 5. A research degree can be pursued with a co-Guide from a related discipline.**
- 6. Inter-disciplinary elective papers will be compulsory under CBCS.**
- 7. Course for PhD and MPhil research will have one shared Methodology Paper for broad disciplinary clusters.**
